No-Peek Stew

2# of stewing meat-cut into 1" chunks	2 or 3 potatoes-peeled/ 1" chunks
3 lg carrots-peeled/ 1" chunks	1 lg onion-chunked
1 15oz can green beans	1 15oz can tomato soup
1 15oz can cream of soup	salt/pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 275, spray a 9X13 casserole dish and add meat, potatoes, carrots and onions. Season to taste. Dump the green beans, juice and all over the top. Next, pour the tomato soup and cream of soup over the top. Gently combine if you want but in not necessary. Tightly cover with foil, place casserole dish on cookie sheet, in case of an overflow. Bake at 275 for about 5 hours, and **DON'T PEEK!!!**

1 yellow cake mix	2 eggs
5T melted butter	2c choc chips or M&Ms

Mix all together and spread into a 9X13 prepared baking dish, bake at 350 for about 20 minutes.


**When I scratched my knee, or if I bumped my head,
