Cheesy Chicken & Broccoli Pockets

1 can cheddar cheese soup

1c chopped broccoli

1c chicken-cooked and boned

1/4c shredded cheese

1 prepared pizza crust

Heat oven to 350 and spray baking sheet. Mix all ingredients until well blended. Unroll the pizza crust and cut into quarters. Spoon about 1/2 cup of chicken mixture on one side of each quarter. Fold the crust in half over the filling. Pinch the edges and seal tightly. Using a sharp knife, cut small slits in the tops of each pocket. Carefully place each pocket on the baking sheet and bake about 20 minutes or until crust is golden brown.

(It does not say to do this step, but I would: brush pockets with one beaten egg. This will make them pretty and shiny. Also, make several batches of this at one time and then freeze individually and then tightly wrap-these would be handy in the freezer for a quick lunch.)



REMINDER TO ALL RESIDENTS:

The following telephone numbers are provided for your use should you experience any dwelling emergency during **non-office hours**. You should always attempt to obtain assistance only in the order these numbers are listed unless you reach a recorded message instructing otherwise.

Rita-----402-984-7227

If you are unable to contact Rita, you may then attempt to reach **Kalynn-----346-4229**

Remember the usual definition of an emergency includes heating problems (in the winter), lockouts, plumbing problems (leaking pipes or running water), electrical problems, or toilet problems. Though it may be uncomfortable, air conditioner failure does not usually constitute an emergency, nor does a light bulb going out; these are matters that will be addressed during normal working hours.

Please do not attempt to directly contact maintenance personnel; these individuals are strictly scheduled as to when they rotate on and off call, and their compensation is adjusted according to their non-duty work schedule. Only in the most extreme case, after trying unsuccessfully to reach Rita, then Kalynn, should you attempt to call any other staff member at home. Additionally, unless extenuating circumstances exist, the resident may expect to pay any charges for having called a professional repair-person without prior housing authority permission.

With your cooperation, we will continue to meet your needs as quickly as possible, while allowing off-duty personnel to enjoy their family time to the fullest extent.
