## MEAT LOAF CASSEROLE

1# hamburger  
1 can veg soup  
2c water  
3/4c milk

1 garlic clove  
1 can cream of soup  
3T margarine  
2c instant mashed potatoes

Brown burger and garlic in skillet and drain. Stir in veggie soup, 1/2 can cream of soup and spread in baking dish. Heat the remaining soup, water and margarine in sauce pan over medium heat, remove from the stove and add the milk, then slowly stir in the potatoes until nicely smooth and thick. Spoon potatoes over the meat mixture and bake at 350 for about 25 minutes or until the potatoes are lightly browned. Sprinkle your favorite shredded cheese on top for the last five minutes.






Leaves fall, the days grow cold.




Though the weather is still very nice,
