CHICKEN AND BROCCOLI CASSEROLE

1 can cream of chicken soup


1/3c milk

Place the broccoli and chicken in prepared baking dish. Stir the soup and milk in small bowl and pour over broccoli and chicken. Sprinkle with the cheese. Mix the bread crumbs and margarine in bowl and pour over the cheese. Bake about 30 minutes at 350 or until it is hot and bubbling. Serve over wild rice with a side of sliced tomatoes.
