

Asparagus and Mozzie Stuffed Chicken Breasts

- 2 lg chicken breasts-boneless/skinless
- 8 asparagus spears
- 1/2c mozzie cheese-shredded
- 1/4c bread crumbs-seasoned
- salt and pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 350-prepare 8X8 baking dish. Place the breasts in a freezer bag and pound out to about 1/4” in thickness. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Put 4 spears of asparagus down center of each breast, and spread about half the cheese on each one. Roll the chicken tightly to form a tidy little roll. Carefully, roll each breast in the bread crumbs and place seam side down in baking dish. Bake about 30 minutes, or until juices run clear when pricked with a fork. Serve over a bed of wild rice. A whole meal ready in less than one hour.
