# WELCOME AUTUMN !!

## **TWO-STEP POUND CAKE**

(easy peasy)

4c flour  
3c sugar  
2c butter-soft

3/4c milk  
6 eggs  
2t vanilla



Preheat oven to 325. Prepare (grease and flour) 10 inch tube pan. Place flour, sugar, butter, milk, eggs and vanilla (in that order) in mixing bowl and using mixer, beat on low for about 1 minute, stop and scrape down the sides and beat on medium for another 2 minutes. Pour in tube pan and smooth out, if needed, bake for about 1 hour 30 minutes, or until long wooden pick comes out clean. Cool in pan on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Remove from pan and cool completely-about an hour.
