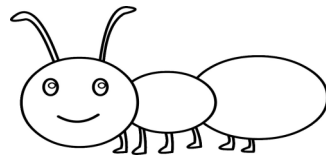

Hot Cheesy Corn Dip

- 4 slices of bacon
- 4oz cream cheese-soft
- 1/4c sour cream

- 3c raw corn
- 2c cheddar cheese shredded
- 1/4c chives-chopped



Preheat oven to 350. In large skillet cook bacon until crispy, remove and let drain on a paper towel, then chop it. In bowl combine corn, cream cheese, cheddar cheese, sour cream, chives and bacon, season to taste with salt. Stir until nicely combined and transfer to a baking dish. Bake until bubbly and warmed through, about 25 to 30 minutes. Serve with tortilla chips or corn chips and start dipping.

Tip-if you can't find fresh chives-do not panic-use fresh green onions instead and all will be well.

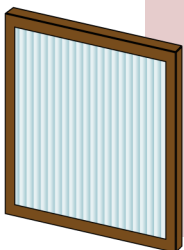
