Check your home for water leaks. Make sure all your switches and outlets are working. Does your alarm need batteries? Are all doors and windows closing properly?



## VERY EASY OREO TRUFFLES





1 16oz pkg of Oreo cookies 2 (8oz) pkg of chocolate chips-melted 1 (8oz) pkg cream cheese-softened

Crush cookies into fine crumbs using food processor-OR-you can also crush cookies using a baggie and rolling pin. Save back *about* 1/3c of the crumbs, place remaining crumbs in a bowl, add cream cheese and mix until well blended. Roll cookie mixture into bite-sized (about 1 inch) balls. Dip each ball into the melted chocolate and place on a waxed paper covered baking sheet. Lightly sprinkle with crumbs that were saved. Refrigerate until firm, about an hour. When completely cooled, remove from baking sheet and store in the fridge, covered.
