


PEACH POUND CAKE

1c margarine-soft 3c flour

2c sugar 1t baking powder

4 eggs 1/2t salt

1t vanilla 2c fresh peaches-pitted and chopped



Preheat oven to 325-prepare a 10 inch tube pan and sprinkle inside with sugar. In large bowl, cream margarine and sugar until fluffy, add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each egg, stir in vanilla. Reserve 1/4 cup of flour for later, sift together the remaining flour, baking powder and salt, gradually stir into the creamed mixture. Use the reserved flour to coat the peaches, then fold peaches into batter. Spread evenly into the prepared pan. Bake for about 60 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean. Cool completely before removing from pan.

HINT: This cake can also be made with fresh apples or cherries.


