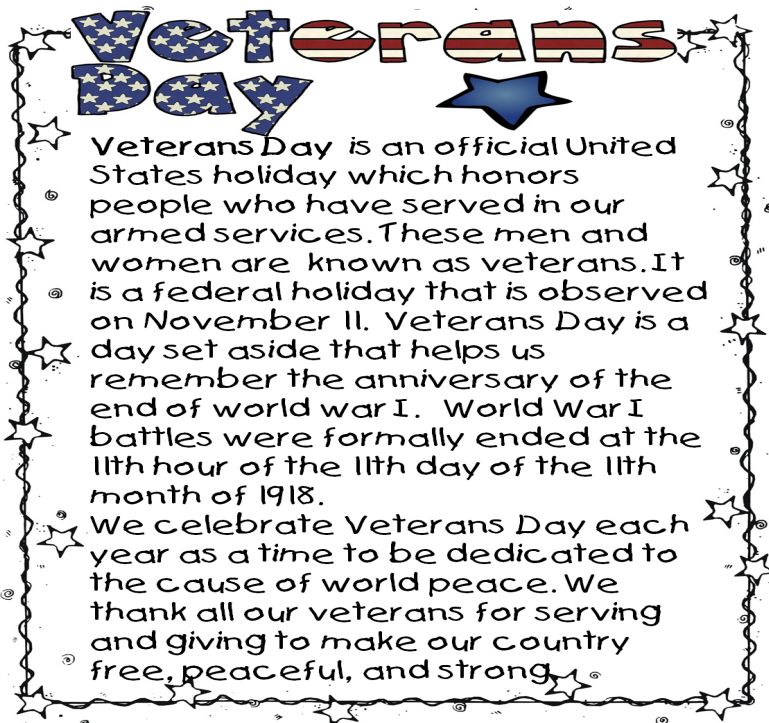

## **TWO VERY DIFFERENT "LEFTOVER" TURKEY RECIPES**

### **#1 Tastes Like Thanksgiving Casserole**

Heat oven to 350 and prepare large baking pan. The first layer is **LO** dressing, you will need to add about 1 cup of broth. In a bowl, combine about 4 cups of chopped **LO** turkey, 2 cans cream of soup (undiluted), 1t garlic powder, 1/4c sour cream, spoon over dressing layer. Using your **LO** mashed potatoes, about 5-6 cups, 1 package of soft cream cheese, 3/4cup sour cream, salt and pepper to taste. Sprinkle top with your favorite shredded cheese.

{You can also add a cup or two of whatever veggie you have **LO**-before you top with the mashed potatoes.}

Bake about 30-35 minutes-or until all is warmed through.

### **#2 Cheddar Turkey Casserole**

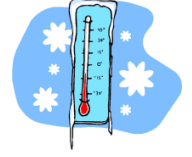
4c spiral pasta-uncooked  
1 1/2c shredded cheese  
1c milk

2 cans cream of soup  
2c of your favorite veggie  
2c cubed turkey

Cook pasta according to directions on package. In sauce pan heat soup, milk, and cheese, until well blended. Add cooked pasta, turkey and veggie and TOSS together. Transfer to baking dish and bake for about 30-35 minutes or until hot and bubbly.
