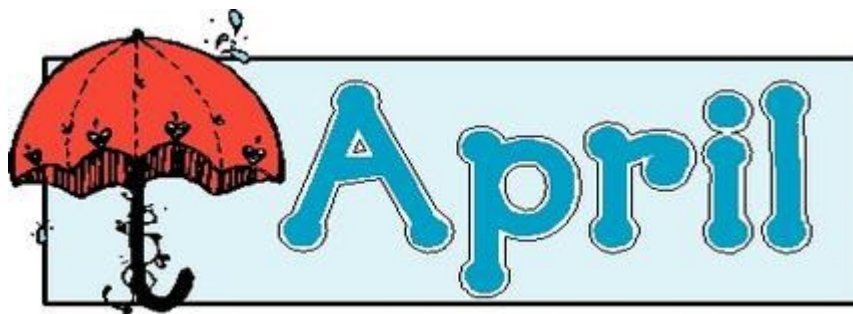

No Smoking Within
25 Feet Of Building

On March 14th the Board of Commissioners unanimously adopted the **new smoke-free policy**. Smoking is now **prohibited** within 25 feet of **all** housing authority buildings.

ATTENTION RESIDENTS OF SCATTERED SITES AND APARTMENTS-

Your smoking disposal containers are ALSO required to be 25 feet from your homes.

Many of you living in homes and apartments still have some general cleaning and housekeeping that
needs to be done to comply with housing standards!

Here a few tips that will help you to get the "ball rolling"-

Divide your home into wet rooms and dry rooms-(start with wet, as they usually need a bit more attention)

Bathroom-clean toilet and seat, counters, sink and tub-sweep/mop floor

Kitchen-(don't use same rags as in the bath)-wipe fridge, stove, counters/cabinets-sweep/mop

All other rooms (dry)-knock down cobwebs, dust light fixtures and walls-dust baseboards-vacuum floors

Use the one minute rule: mail clutter, dirty dishes or just putting things away, if you can do it in under a minute-**DO IT NOW!**

Break it down: choose a task/chore and set a timer for 10 minutes-do as much as you can before timer goes off-

VERY EASY MEATBALLS

| 1# hamburger | 1T mustard (optional) |
| 3/4c seasoned croutons-crushed | 1t red pepper flakes (optional) |
| 1/4c onion-chopped | 1t Cajun seasoning |
| 1 egg-beaten | 1t olive oil |
| 2 cloves garlic-chopped | 1t margarine |
| 3T soy sauce or Worcestershire sauce | |



In large bowl mix all ingredients, except the oil and margarine, until well blended. Form by hand into meatballs about the size of a large walnut. Heat the oil and margarine in skillet over medium heat, place meatballs in oil and cook, turning as needed until they done to your liking, about 10/15 minutes. Serve with spaghetti and sauce, bbq sauce over rice, cream of soup over wild rice. This recipe can be easily adapted to fit your taste.

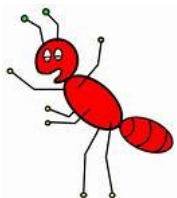

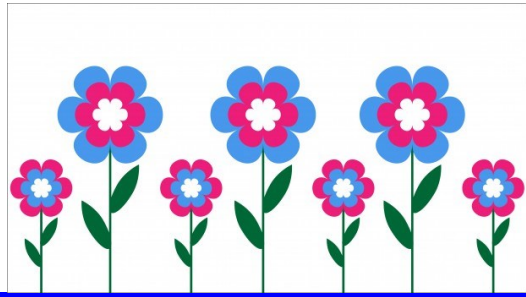
