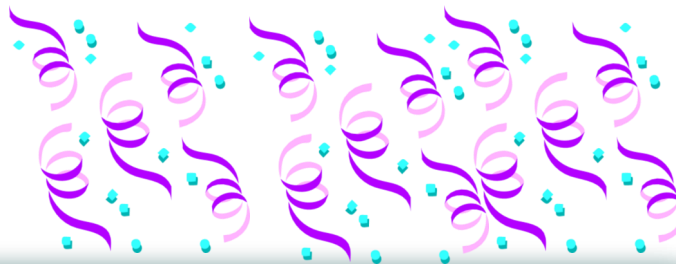
The first lunches of the new year will be on the 4th and 18th.

The Best Mac 'N Cheese Ever!

1# elbow macaroni
1c evaporated milk
4 lg eggs
1 sour cream-16 oz
2t seasoned salt

2t black pepper
2c cheddar cheese-shredded
2c Monterey Jack cheese-shredded
6 slices of cheese-each torn into 4
1/2c margarine-melted

Preheat oven to 350 and prepare a 9X13 baking dish with cooking spray. Bring a large pot of water to boil, cook macaroni for about 8 minutes and drain, pour into the baking dish. Beat eggs, sour cream, salt and pepper into a smooth mixture. Stir in the two shredded cheeses until thoroughly combined. Pour over macaroni and mix well. Top casserole with the torn pieces of processed cheese. Drizzle melted butter over casserole, especially along the sides. Bake about 30 minutes or until bubbly and starting to turn brown.

Got any left over Christmas ham-chop up a couple of cups and add. YUM!

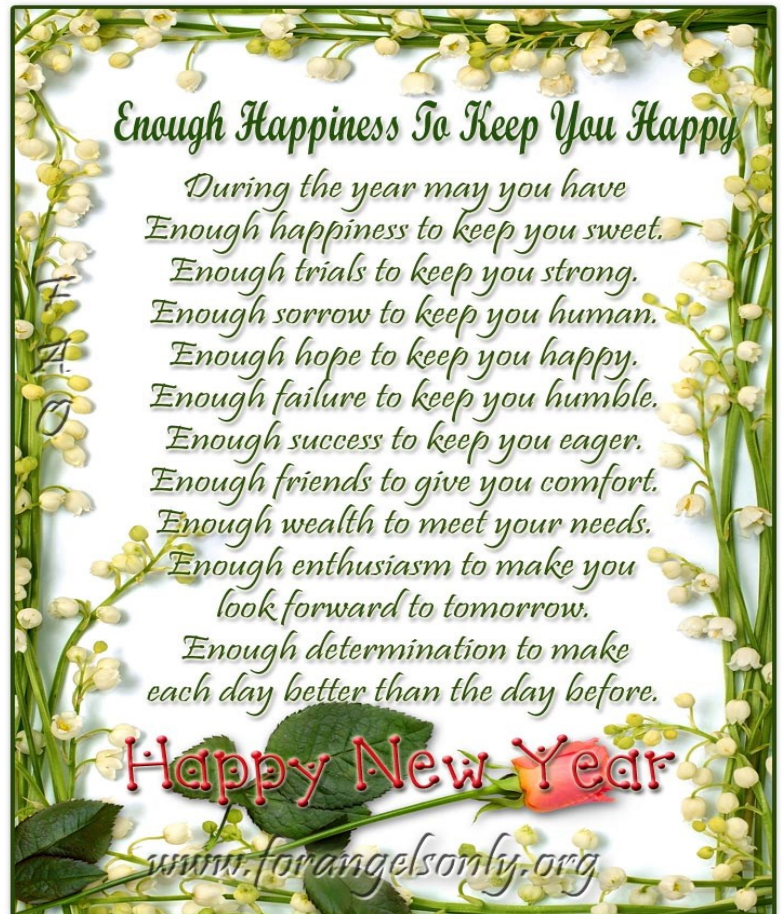
