CHICKEN & WILD RICE CASSEROLE

| 2 pkgs wild rice mix | 1/4c butter |
| 4 celery ribs-chopped | 2 md onions-chopped |
| 5c chicken-cooked/chopped | 2 can cream of soup |
| 2 cans water chestnuts-drained | 1 (8oz) sour cream |
| 1c milk | 1/2t salt and 1/2t pepper |
| 4c cheddar cheese-divided | 2c fresh breadcrumbs-cubed |
| 1 sm pkg sliced almond (optional) | |

Preheat oven to 350 and prepare rice mix according to directions on box. Melt butter in large skillet and add celery and onions, saute for about 10 minutes until tender. Stir in chicken and all of other ingredients, (except the breadcrumbs) rice mix and 3 cups of the cheese. Spoon into a lightly greased baking dish. Top with the breadcrumbs. Bake about 35 minutes, sprinkle remaining cheese and top with the almonds. Bake about five more minutes.

This will make about 10 generous servings. Make this special side dish to take along for Thanksgiving dinner.
