On Wednesday the 18th lunch will be a baked potato bar, with many choices of toppings.

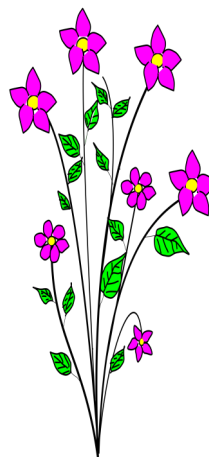
Hope many of you will be able to join us for lunch and to chat with your neighbors after the long winter.

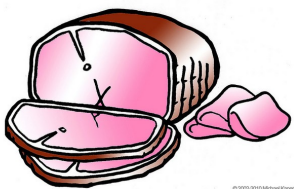

### **LEFTOVER HAM AND CHEESE BRUNCH BAKE**

(this is a great way to use your leftovers)

| 10 eggs          | 1 1/2c milk                     |
| 1t garlic powder | 4c cubed bread (use leftovers)  |
| 1/2# ham-chopped | salt & pepper to taste          |
|                  | 1 1/2c favorite cheese-shredded |



Preheat oven to 350 and prepare baking casserole. In large bowl add eggs, milk, garlic powder, salt and pepper-whisk until well blended. In baking dish, put in the bread cubes and top with ham and cheese. Pour the egg mixture over. Bake until eggs are set, about 45 or 50 minutes.

Hint-if you have a small amount of leftover boiled potatoes, chop them up and add to casserole, or any veggie would work also. (clean out the fridge)
