SUNBURN INFO FROM THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF DERMATOLOGY



First, always protect your skin by using sunscreen with a high number.

BUT, if you do get a sunburn follow these tips:

- * if you notice a sunburn starting-GO INDOORS-or at least get out of the sun
- * once inside take frequent cool baths or showers-pat yourself dry-don't rub
- * if you can stand a bit of rubbing-**gently** apply moisturizer containing aloe or soy
- * if you have any areas that seem especially uncomfortable-use hydrocortisone cream
- * DO NOT use "caine" products (such as benzocaine) these will irritate more than help
 - * consider taking ibuprofen to help reduce swelling and ease your pain
 - * **DRINK EXTRA WATER** to help prevent dehydration
- * if your skin should blister-leave them alone and allow them to heal slowly

Take extra care to protect your sunburned skin while it heals-cover up when you go outdoors



OATMEAL BROWNIES

1c margarine-room temp
1c brown sugar-packed
1/2c white sugar
2 eggs
2t vanilla
1/2t salt

1t baking powder
1 1/2 c flour
2c oatmeal
chocolate chips-optional
raisins-optional
chopped nuts-optional

1t baking soda



Heat oven to 350. Prep 9X13 baking pan. In large bowl, beat margarine and both sugars until creamy. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, gradually add in all the other ingredients. Mix well to moisten all the ingredients and spread into the baking pan. Bake about 20 to 25 minutes. Let cool about 5 minutes before cutting into bars.

ATTENTION SUNRISE RESIDENTS

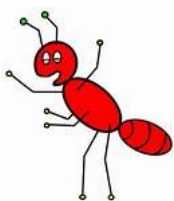
On Thursday, July 12th,

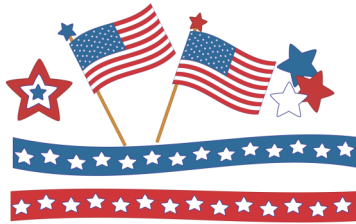
