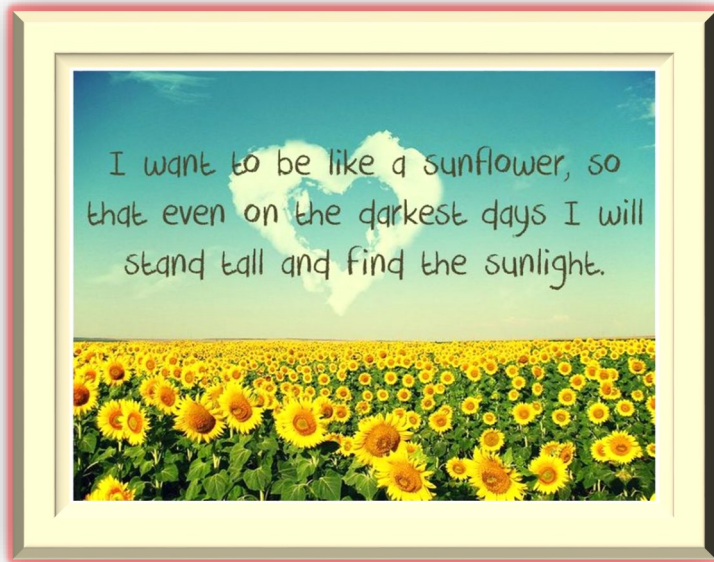
The office has recently received notice that

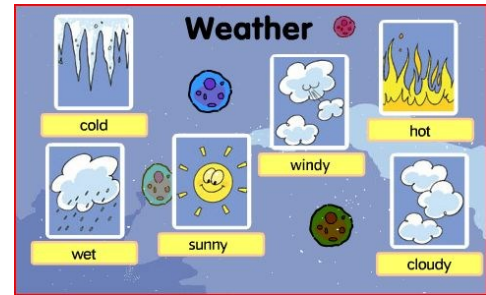

IT'S ZUCCHINI TIME

Parmesan Zucchini Fritters

- | | |
|--------------------|-----------------------------|
| 1c zucchini-grated | 1/2 onion-chopped |
| 3 eggs | 1/2t garlic powder |
| 1/2t salt | 1/2t pepper |
| 1/2c parm-grated | 3/4c flour |
| 1 1/2T olive oil | your favorite dipping sauce |



Use the large holes of the grater and grate the zucchini. Using paper towels squeeze out as much liquid as possible. In a large bowl, combine shredded zucchini with onion, eggs, and garlic powder. Season with salt and pepper and stir to combine well. Mix in the parm cheese and flour. Heat olive oil in skillet, scoop about 1/4c of batter and cook until golden, about 2 minutes per side. Serve with your favorite marinara dipping sauce.

Zucchini Enchiladas

|----------------------------------|----------------------------|
| 1T olive oil | 1 large onion-chopped |
| 1t salt | 2 cloves garlic-minced |
| 2t ground cumin | 2t chili powder |
| 3c chicken-cooked/shredded | 1 1/3c red enchilada sauce |
| 4 lg zucchinis-halved lengthwise | 1c Monterey Jack-shredded |
| 1c cheddar-shredded | sour cream |

Preheat oven to 350, in large skillet heat oil, add onion and season with salt. Cook until soft, about five minutes, then add garlic, cumin and chili powder, stir until well combined. Add chicken and one cup of enchilada sauce, stir until well combined. On a cutting board, use a y-shaped veggie peeler to make thin slices of zucchini. Lay out three, slightly overlapping, and place a spoonful of chicken mixture on top, roll up and transfer to a baking dish. Repeat until all is used up. Spoon remaining 1/3cup of sauce over enchiladas and sprinkle with both cheeses. Bake about 20 minutes, or until cheese is all melty. Top with sour cream and enjoy.

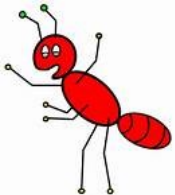

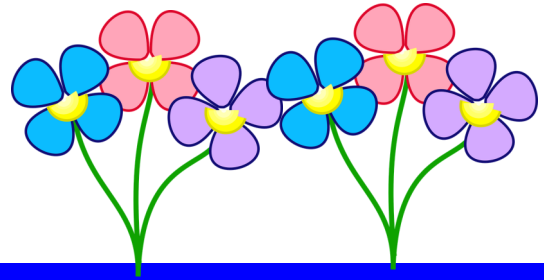
