Hope you can join us for food and fun.

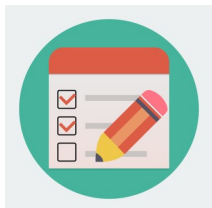

And they fashioned it with care.

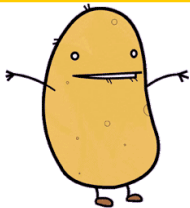
One was a teacher, the tools used,

ZUCCHINI AND POTATO BAKE



This time of year if you or anyone you know has a garden-the zucchini is usually coming out of their ears.

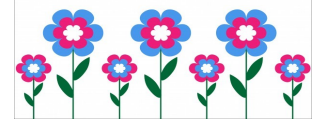
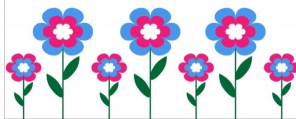
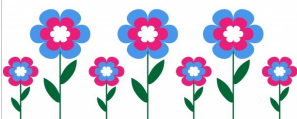
This is a tasty and easy recipe to use up some of that zucchini.

2 md zucchini-cut into large chunks
1 md bell pepper-seeded/chopped
1 clove garlic-sliced
paprika to taste

4 md potatoes-peeled/cut into large chunks
1/2c bread crumbs
1/4c olive oil
salt to taste

pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 400. In baking pan, toss together the zucchini, potatoes, bell pepper, garlic, bread crumbs and olive oil, until well blended. Season with the salt, pepper and paprika. Bake about 1 hour, stirring occasionally, until the potatoes are fork tender and lightly browned. If you like your veggies on the crisp side, you could put them under the broiler for a couple minutes.



MOSQUITOS AND TICKS

With the unusually large amount of rain we have had this spring and summer that can only mean one thing-

YOU AND ME!!!



Spending time with family outdoors is good for everyone. Don't let mosquito and tick bites ruin your fun. Most bug bites are harmless, but some spread germs that can make you sick. Some of these germs are very serious- and may even be deadly.

Protect yourself from bug bites:

Use repellent-one that contains DEET-when inside wash off
warm water and soap

Wear long-sleeved shirts, long pants and socks

Check everyone when for ticks when they come inside-
under arms-around ears-waist-hair

Take a shower within 2 hours to help wash away any bugs

Check pets for any bugs when they come inside



Keep mosquitoes and ticks out of and away from your home:

Repair any window or door screens

Don't leave doors propped open

Empty any containers with standing water

Mow the lawn often

Removing an attached tick:

Use tweezers to remove tick as soon as you see it

Grab the tick near the head (the part closest to your skin)

Gently pull the tick straight out-be careful not to crush or
twist the tick

Clean you hands and the tick bite area with rubbing alcohol
or soap and water





NEVER use other things like nail polish or a hot match to kill
or remove a tick

The best way to get rid of the tick is flush him right down.

Contact your doctor if you get sick after a tick bite.
