**CHUNKY APPLE CAKE**

1/2c butter

1/2t vanilla

2c flour

1t nutmeg

1/2t baking soda

2c sugar

2 eggs

1 1/2t cinnamon

1/2t salt

6c apples-peeled/chopped



**BUTTERSCOTCH SAUCE:**

1/2c brown sugar

1/4c butter

1/2c heavy whipping cream

In a large bowl, cream butter, sugar and vanilla, add eggs one at a time, beating well after each one. Combine flour, cinnamon, nutmeg, salt and soda, gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well (batter will be stiff). Stir in apples until well combined.

Spread in a prepared 13X9 baking dish. Bake at 350 for about 45/50 minutes or until top is lightly browned and springs back when lightly touched. Cool about 30 minutes before serving. Meanwhile, in sauce pan, combine brown sugar and butter, cook over medium heat until butter is melted, gradually add cream and bring to slow boil, stirring constantly. Remove from heat, serve over the cake.

## MARCH WEATHER LORE

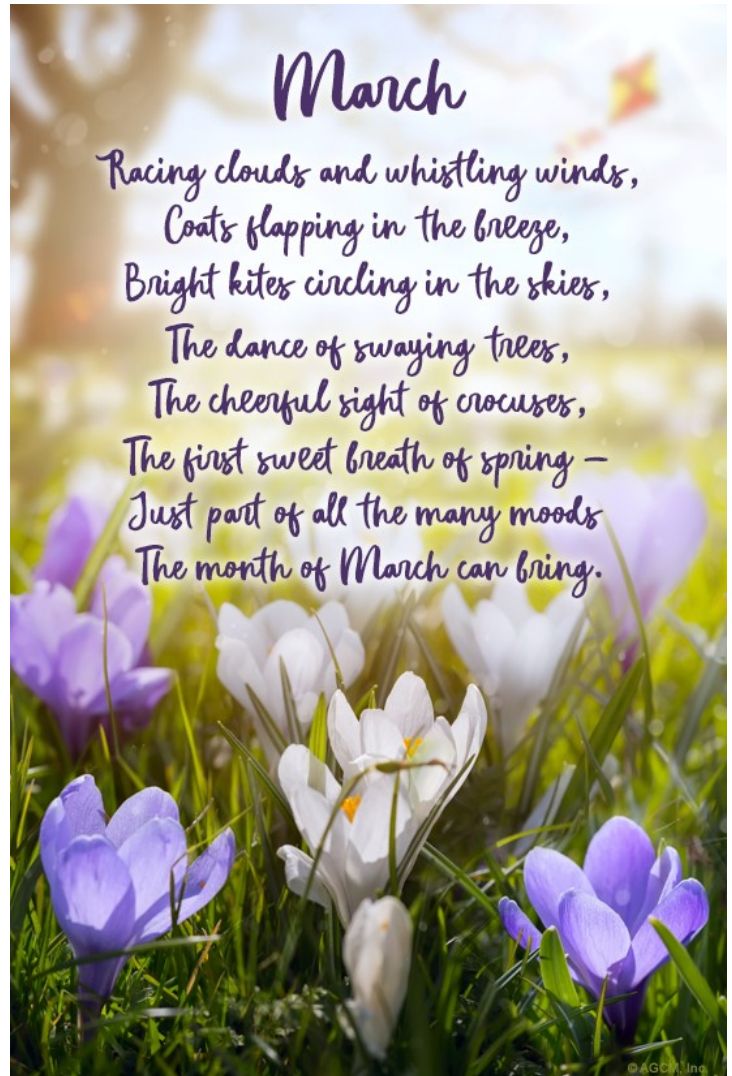
If March comes in like a lion, it will go
