"COMFORTING" CHICKEN NOODLE SOUP

2 qts water	8t chicken bouillon granules
6 1/2c wide noodles-uncooked	2 can cream of chicken soup-undiluted
3c cooked chicken-cubed (use leftovers)	1c sour cream

In large pot, bring water and bouillon to a boil. Add noodles, cook until tender, about 10 minutes. DO NOT DRAIN. Add cream of soup and chicken and heat through. Remove from heat and stir in the sour cream.

This makes about 3 quarts of tasty and **easy** soup.

HERE ARE A COUPLE HINTS: I like to use frozen noodles, really gives it that homemade taste and look. Also, chop a carrot or two and dice a small onion, cook along with the noodles for extra flavor.

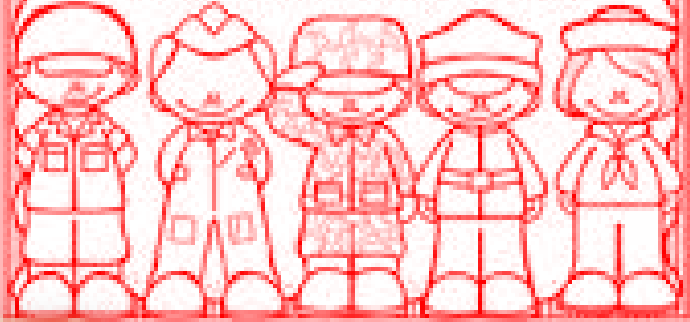


VETERAN'S DAY
