FAST AND EASY CHICKEN ENCHILADAS

1 jar salsa-your favorite

2c grated cheese-your favorite

1 sm red onion-chopped fine

1 rotisserie chicken-remove skin and bones

1c sour cream

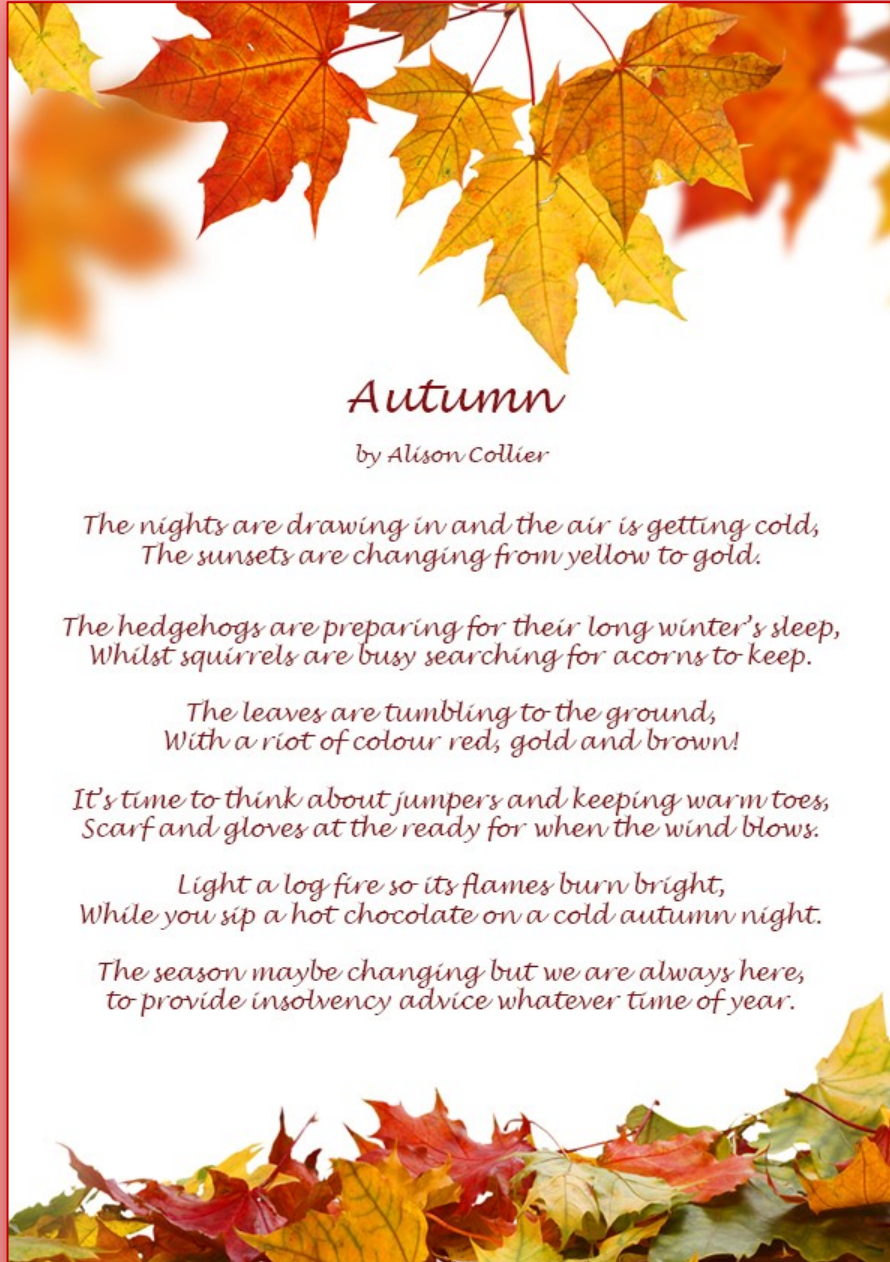
salt and pepper to taste

6-8” flour tortillas



Preheat oven to 350 and prepare a 9X13 baking dish. To prepare enchiladas: place shredded chicken in large bowl, add half of the grated cheese, sour cream and onion, season with salt and pepper. Mix well to combine. Place the tortillas on your work surface and spoon about 1 cup on the chicken mixture across the center of each tortilla. Roll each one and place seam side down in baking dish. Pour salsa over the enchiladas, cover with foil and bake for about 40 minutes. Remove the foil and sprinkle the remaining cheese over the enchiladas, return the baking dish back to the oven until the cheese is melted and edges of the tortillas are just starting to get crisp, about 5 to 8 minutes. Serve hot.

This recipe can be as spicy as you like, simply by adding a couple hot peppers or by using HOT salsa.
