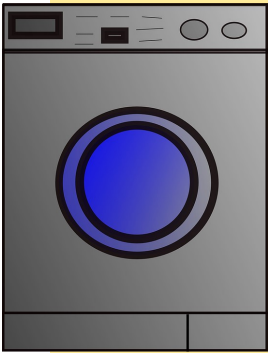

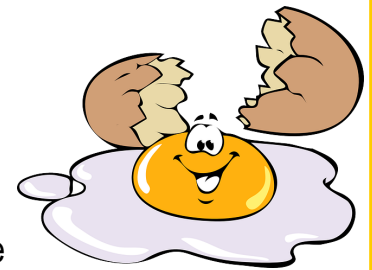

**Are you planning a "late night" on New Year's Eve-this make ahead breakfast casserole is just what you need. Make it the night before and store covered in the fridge.**

### HEARTY BRUNCH CASSEROLE

4c frozen hash browns-thawed	1# sausage-browned and drained
1/2# bacon-cooked and crumbled	1 green pepper-chopped
1 sm onion-chopped	2c cheddar cheese-shredded
4 large eggs	3c milk
1c biscuit/baking mix	1/2t salt

In large bowl, combine hash browns, sausage, bacon, green pepper and onion, stir in 1 cup of the cheese. Transfer to a prepared 13X9 baking dish. In the same bowl you already used, whisk eggs, baking mix and salt until blended. Pour over the top of hash brown layer, sprinkle on the remaining cheese. Cover and put in the fridge overnight. Preheat oven to 350 and bake casserole uncovered for about 30-35 minutes or until a knife inserted in center comes out clean. Let stand about 10 minutes before serving. Makes about 12 hearty servings.
