

## EASTER DINNER

(serves about six)

### Savory Pork Roast

1 1/2T fresh rosemary  
1/2t dried thyme  
3# pork loin

2t garlic salt  
1/4t pepper

In large zipper bag, mix all the seasonings, place roast in bag and seal, toss until thoroughly coated. Transfer to prepared baking dish. Cook about 1 hour at 350 or to an internal temp of 145.

### Oven Roasted Red Potatoes and Asparagus


1 1/2# red potatoes-cut into chunks  
8 cloves garlic-sliced thin  
4t dried thyme  
1 bunch of asparagus-cut into 2-3 inches pieces

2T olive oil  
4t dried rosemary  
pepper to taste  
2t salt

In large baking dish, toss potatoes with 1/2 the olive oil, garlic, rosemary, thyme and 1/2 the salt. Cover with foil, bake about 30 minutes at 350. Add in the asparagus, remaining oil and salt, cover and bake about 20 more minutes. Remove the foil and bake uncovered another 5 or 10 minutes, until potatoes are lightly browned. Season with pepper to serve.

(If you have good timing-both should be down about the same time)
