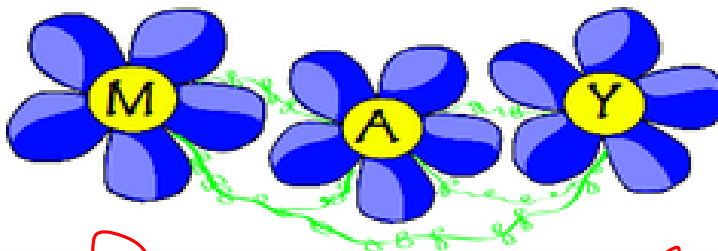

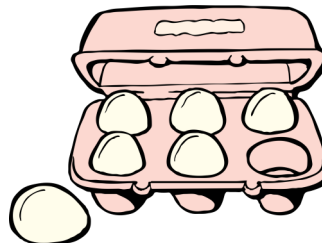
MAY LUNCH

SPRINGTIME PASTA TOSS

1# pkg pasta-use your favorite

1 1/2# chicken breasts

1 bunch of asparagus-cut into 2" lengths

1 sm onion-chopped

2c heavy cream

4T olive oil-about

8T margarine-about

1/2c frozen peas

1 lemon-juiced and zested

1 1/2c parmesan cheese-freshly grated

1T fresh chives or parsley-chopped



Cook pasta according to package directions-until al dente-still slightly firm. Drain pasta and toss in colander with olive oil. Cut chicken into about 1-inch pieces and salt and pepper to taste, put into a nonstick skillet with olive oil and brown until lightly golden all over, about 5-6 minutes, remove from pan. Using the same pan, with a bit of olive oil and margarine, add the asparagus, onion, and peas, saute for about 4-5 minutes, move these veggies to the pasta colander. Still using the same pan, over medium heat add whatever margarine is remaining, when melted whisk in the heavy cream and the parm cheese, simmer for a couple minutes, toss in the veggies/pasta and chicken bites. Heat through, stir in the lemon juice and zest. Garnish with fresh chives or parsley. Serve with some freshly toasted garlic bread.

DO YOU REALLY UNDERSTAND THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE?
