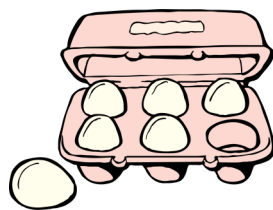

Thanksgiving in a crock pot

4 skinless chicken breasts

1/2 sour cream

1 can cream of chicken soup

6oz box of stuffing mix

1/3c chicken broth

salt and pepper to taste

Spray crock pot with cooking spray and place chicken in pot. Season as you like. Sprinkle the stuffing mix over the chicken. Mix the broth, sour cream and soup together until well blended. Spread over the stuffing mix and even out as best you can. Cover and cook on low for about 4 hours.

(I would add a can of French style green beans on the top-a meal all in one)

German Chocolate Dump Cake

1c shredded coconut

1 pkg devil's food cake mix

1/2c butter-melted

2c powdered sugar

1 1/2c pecans-chopped

8oz cream cheese-soft

2t vanilla

1/2c chocolate chips-semisweet

Heat oven to 350 and prepare 13X9 pan. Sprinkle coconut and 1 cup of pecans into pan. Prepare cake mix using package direction. Pour batter over nuts/coconut. In large bowl, beat cream cheese, butter and vanilla until smooth, beat in the powdered sugar. Add in the chocolate chips and remaining pecans. Spoon over batter. Cut thorough the batter with a knife to swirl just a bit. Bake about 35-40

READY OR NOT-HEAR IT COMES

Winter storms including blizzards can bring extreme cold, freezing rain, snow, ice and high winds.

A winter storm can:

- last a few hours or several days
- cut off heat, power and communication services
- put older adults, children, sick individuals and pets at greater risk

WINTER STORM WARNING

Issued when hazardous winter weather in the form of heavy snow, heavy freezing rain, or heavy sleet is imminent or occurring. Winter storm warnings are usually issued 12 to 24 hours before the event is expected to begin.

WINTER STORM WATCH

Alerts the public to the possibility of a blizzard, heavy snow, heavy freezing rain, or heavy sleet. Winter storm watches are usually issued 12 to 48 hours before the beginning of a winter storm.

WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY

Issued for accumulations of snow, freezing rain, freezing drizzle, and sleet which will cause significant inconveniences and, if caution is not exercised, could lead to life-threatening situations.

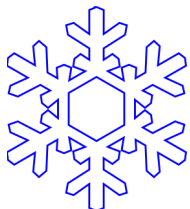
STAY SAFE DURING WINTER WEATHER

Pay attention to weather reports. Listen for emergency information and alerts. Stay off roads if possible, if trapped in your car, then stay in your car. Limit your time outside, if you need to go outside, wear layers of warm clothing. Watch for signs of frostbite and hypothermia. Do not overexert when shoveling snow and walking in the snow.

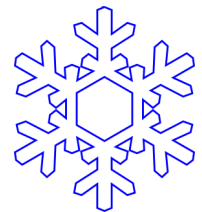
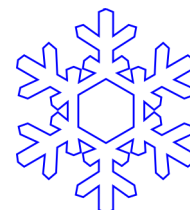
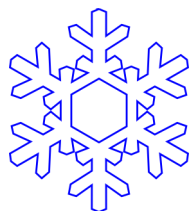
