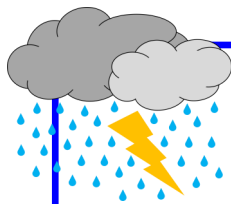

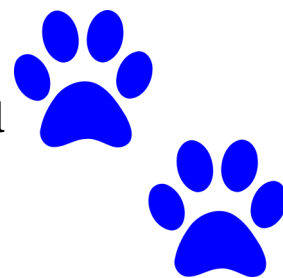


## ATTENTION ALL PET OWNERS

### HASHBROWN AND EGG CASSAROLE

1 2# bag of hashbrowns-thawed

1 sm onion

1/2c milk

1/2t garlic powder

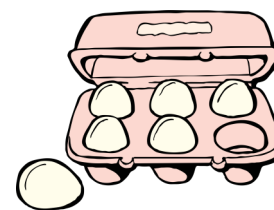
1# sausage

5 eggs

1/2t onion powder

salt and pepper to taste

12oz shredded cheese-use your favorite



Preheat oven to 350 and prepare a two quart baking dish. In a skillet brown the sausage and onion until crumbly and no longer pink, drain. Meanwhile, whisk together the eggs, milk, onion and garlic powder, salt and pepper and pour over the potatoes. Layer with half to cheese, the sausage mixture and the remaining cheese. Cover with foil and bake for one hour, remove foil and bake for about 10 more minutes. A knife inserted in the center should come out clean. Let rest for about five minutes before serving. You could add a nice sized dollop of sour cream on each serving.

What a wonderful meal to have before going to church on Easter Sunday!
