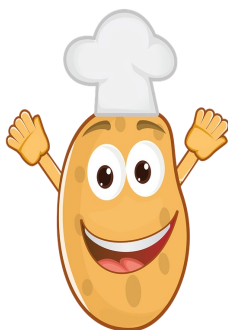

Stuffed Zucchini

|--------------------------|-----------------------------|
| 3 md zucchini | 1# sausage |
| 1c bread crumbs or panko | 1/2c Parmesan cheese |
| 1 garlic clove-minced | 1 jar pasta sauce |
| | 1/2c mozzie cheese-shredded |



Trim stems from squash and slice lengthwise, scoop out the seeds. Mix the sausage, crumbs, Parm cheese, and garlic. Fill each squash half with sausage mixture and arrange in a 9X13 baking pan. Pour sauce over the top and cover with aluminum foil. Bake in a 350 degree oven for about 45 minutes, remove foil and sprinkle with the mozzie cheese and bake until cheese is melted and bubbly, about another 15 minutes.

Chocolate Pudding Pizza

|----------------------------------|---|
| 1 pkg peanut butter cookie dough | 1 carton (12oz) spreadable cream cheese |
| 1 3/4c cold milk | 1 pkg instant chocolate pudding mix |
| 1 8oz whipped topping-thawed | 1/4c mini chocolate chips |

Evenly press cookie dough out on at greased pizza pan. Bake at 350 for about 15 minutes-just until set. Cool. Beat cream cheese until very smooth and fluffy, spread over the crust. In another bowl beat the milk and pudding mix for about two minutes, spread over the cream cheese layer. Refrigerate until set, about 20 minutes. Spread the whipped topping over the top and sprinkle with the mini chips. Chill for another hour or so before serving, **if you can wait that long.**
