

Last month we chatted about the dos and don'ts of toilets. This month it's all about drains, both kitchen and bathroom drains.



### **DO NOT PUT “STUFF” DOWN THE DRAINS!!**

Drains are not intended to take table scraps or leftover cooking grease. Even during a normal sink of dishes there is some greasy residue, be sure to run plenty of water after doing dishes to make sure nothing gets caught in the drain trap.

**Your drain is not a garbage disposal.**



### **CRESCENT LAYER BARS**

1 can crescent roll dough

1c chocolate chips

1c cashew pieces

1c white vanilla baking chips

1c slivered almonds

1 can (14oz) sweetened condensed milk



Heat oven to 350 and prepare 13X9 inch pan. Unroll dough in to pan and press seams together and about a half inch up all four pan sides. Bake 5 minutes and remove from oven. Sprinkle all chips and nuts evenly over the crust. Pour condensed milk evenly over top. Return to oven and bake for another 20 to 25 minutes longer or until golden brown. Cool about 1 hour in the fridge or until the chocolate is set. Cut and serve.

If the crescent roll dough **sheets** are available, they work great for this recipe too.

Will March come in like a lion and go out like a lamb or will it be the other way?






