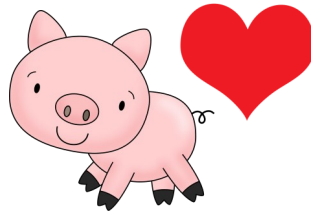

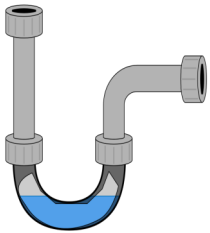
*** NOTICE TO ALL ***

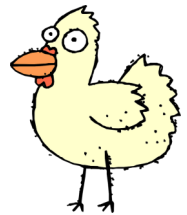
CHICKEN PARMIGIANA

(the name makes it sound hard, but in fact is it very easy)

1 egg-beaten	1/2 c bread crumbs or panko crumbs
2 chicken breast halves-skinless/boneless	1 16oz jar of spaghetti sauce
2oz mozzie cheese-shredded	1/4c parmesan cheese

Heat oven to 350 and lightly grease a baking pan. Put egg and crumbs into separate bowls. Dip chicken into the egg then into the crumbs. Place coated chicken into baking pan. Bake until no longer pink, for about 40 minutes, remove from oven. Gently remove the chicken and set aside. Pour half of the spaghetti sauce in pan, place the chicken on the sauce, then cover chicken with remaining sauce. Sprinkle both cheeses on top and bake for about 20 minutes more, or until cheese is melted.

Serve with a twice baked potato or your favorite pasta.
(There should be plenty of extra sauce in the baking pan.)
