IT'S CROCK POT (SUMMER) TIME –Keep your home cool-NO stove needed
Crock Pot Peach Cobbler

1 1/4c flour2T sugar1t baking powder1/4t cinnamon1/8t salt1 lg egg-room temp1/4c milk-warmed2T butter-melted6c fresh peaches-peeled/sliced-about 6 lg2T brown sugar1T lemon juice1T vanilla

Whisk together 1cup flour, sugar, baking powder, cinnamon and salt. In another bowl mix the egg, milk and butter, add to dry ingredients, stir just until moistened-will be thick. Spread onto bottom of greased slow cooker. Combine peaches, remaining flour, brown sugar, lemon juice and vanilla, spoon over batter. Cook, covered, on high until peach mixture is bubbly, about 1 3/4 to 2 hours. Serve warm and top with ice cream or whipped topping.

	Spicy Crock Pot Mac 'n Cheese	2 1/2c milk	
1# elbow macaroni	10 oz can diced tomatoes with green chiles	2 1/2c milk	
12oz evaporated milk	1t salt	1/2t pepper	
1/4c butter	8oz cheddar cheese-grated	6oz American cheese	

Spray pot with cooking spray, add all ingredients to crock pot and stir to combine, make sure the macaroni is submerged as much as possible. Place the lid on and cook for about 2-3 hours on low-depending on your cooker. When pasta is done, stir one more time and enjoy. (Check out your fridge-if you have any leftover dabs of meat or chicken, chop it up and add to the pot. Also, add a bit of sour cream for even more flavor)
