
ATTENTION ALL PET OWNERS

BISCUITS AND GRAVY CASSEROLE

~~This would be perfect for Easter morning or any morning~~

For the sausage gravy:

|------------|------------------|-----------------|
| 1# sausage | 1/4c butter | 1/3c flour |
| 4c milk | 1t seasoned salt | 1t black pepper |

For the casserole:

- | | | |
|-----------|--------------------|------------------------------------|
| 6 eggs | 1/2c milk | 2c shredded cheddar cheese-divided |
| 1/2t salt | 1/4 t black pepper | 2 cans tube biscuits |

GRAVY— crumble and brown the sausage. Use a slotted spoon and remove the sausage to a plate, leave the dripping in the skillet. Add butter and let melt over low heat. Sprinkle the flour over the drippings, stir to combine. Let cook about 2 minutes, until the flour is lightly toasted. While stirring, slowly add the milk, increase the heat to medium, stir occasionally. Once the mixture boils and thickens reduce heat to low. Add the seasoned salt and pepper, let this simmer for about 10 minutes, stir just a bit. Set aside.

CASSEROLE—heat oven to 350. Whisk eggs, milk, 1/2 cup of cheese, salt and pepper in medium bowl, pour this mixture into a prepared 13X9 inch baking dish. Reserve 1/2 cup of the sausage, and sprinkle the remainder over the eggs. Next, arrange the biscuits on top in an even layer. Drizzle half of the gravy over the biscuits and sprinkle with the rest of the cheese and the reserved 1/2 cup of sausage. Bake until the biscuits are cooked through and the top is toasted, about 30-35 minutes. Reheat the remaining gravy and drizzle over the biscuits.


